THE VIEW FROM THE BAY

USE YOUR 

PIERHEAD BUILDING

Built in 1897, this Grade I listed red brick and terracotta building was originally the headquarters of the Cardiff Railway Company.

THE SENEDD

The Senedd (Welsh parliament) was opened by Queen Elizabeth II on St David's Day in 2006, and the building makes extensive use of Welsh materials such as slate and oak.



CARDIFF BAY BARRAGE

The barrage is a man-made barrier across the Bay which helps prevent flooding. It's perfect for a relaxing stroll or bike ride, with views over the Severn Estuary.

ROALD DAHL PLASS

Named after the Cardiff-born author, Roald Dahl Plass is a public plaza in the heart of Cardiff Bay.

NORWEGIAN CHURCH

Built in 1868, Cardiff's Norwegian Church started life as a meeting place for Norwegian seafarers during the industrial revolution. This white wood-panelled building is still a church, but also hosts exhibitions and art events.
